SBDM Regular Meeting Minutes January 9, 2017 5:00 p.m. Conference Room

Angie Akers called the meeting to order at 5:03p.m.

1. Opening Business

a. Approval of the agenda—Jason Elder made the motion to approve the agenda and Beverly Smalley seconded. Council approved by consensus.

b. Approval of the minutes from the December 12, 2016 meeting—Kelly Rawlings made the motion to approve the minutes and Jamie Smothers seconded. Council approved by consensus.
