## **SBDM Dress Code Policy**

The way an individual dresses affects that individual's performance, and can also affect the performance of others. MCMS expects all students to adhere to the following:

1. Students will be covered from the collar bone to the knee, sleeveless garments are prohibited. No undergarments will be visible.
2. Any style of skirt, dress, shorts, etc. must be to the knee.
3. Pants will not have holes and will be worn at waist level.
4. Overalls are to be worn correctly, fastened at the waist and with appropriate shirt/blouse.
5. Yoga pants and leggings are prohibited unless worn under an outer garment that is knee length.
6. No hats, caps, sunglasses as headbands, or other head coverings are to be worn in the school building.
7. Heavy winter coats/coveralls will be kept in the lockers during the school day. Lightweight sweaters or sweatshirts may be worn in the classroom for comfort.
8. Book bags, purses, athletic bags, lunch containers, backpacks, cinch back packs, etc. will be kept in the lockers during the school day.
9. Pajamas are prohibited, unless special permission is given by the principal.
10. House shoes are prohibited.
11. Garments or items of jewelry will not advertise drugs or alcohol. Clothing or accessories containing obscene, lewd, offensive or suggestive messages are prohibited.
12. The wearing of gang-related items or clothing style is prohibited.
13. Sunglasses that are not necessary for a medical impairment are prohibited in the school building.
14. Visibility of tattoos is prohibited.
15. Jewelry worn as body piercing, other than ears is prohibited.
  - The principal retains discretionary powers to what constitutes acceptable appearance and whether a student's attire could cause a classroom disturbance or is a school safety issue.
  - Dress code violations will be dealt with on an individual basis. The student will be asked to call home for a change of clothing. If this isn't possible, then they will be given a change of clothes from FRYSC to wear throughout the school day.
  - Consequences will be based upon frequency and degree of severity.
