Extracurricular Programs Policy

Organization

We support extracurricular programs based on the following criteria:

1. Contribution to students becoming self-sufficient individuals of good character exhibiting the qualities of altruism, citizenship, courtesy, honesty, human worth, justice, knowledge, respect, responsibility, and self-discipline.
2. Contribution to students becoming responsible members of a family, work group, or community including demonstrating effectiveness in community service.
3. Student interest.
4. Ability to arrange suitable adult supervision.
5. Ability to attract students currently not involved in extracurricular or service projects.
6. Ability to enhance or maintain equity in the overall extracurricular program.

The following extracurricular programs will be provided.

1. Athletics
2. Staff/community/student sponsored student organizations (clubs)
3. Academics

Eligibility Guidelines

1. Students must be passing all classes during a weekly grade check based upon what is on Infinite Campus at the time of the check. Teachers are accountable for keeping grades updated and verbal or written notes will not replace what is on Infinite Campus unless problems exist with IC. If a student is failing one or more classes during the grade check they will be allowed to participate in practice activities until the next grade check but cannot attend or participate in any games. Any student continuously (four or more weeks) having failing grades in a subject or subjects may not be allowed to participate in extracurricular activities.
2. Students assigned to after-school detention (ASD) will be required to serve the full time of ASD before leaving for any extracurricular events. Students assigned to in-school detention (ISD) or suspended cannot be on campus during the actual ISD/suspension and cannot participate in any games during the same week.
3. In order to participate in a game, students must be in attendance at school for at least a half day on the day of the activity. Final decision is the discretion of the principal.
4. Students will meet any requirements set by a sponsoring organization the school has chosen to join. Each sponsor/coach will submit any additional requirements not listed to the principal prior to the beginning of the season for the particular activity in which students will be involved during a school year.

Coach/Sponsor

An adult coach or sponsor who meets the criteria and is appointed by the principal will manage and supervise each extracurricular activity. The coach or sponsor will be responsible for supervising all students while they are waiting for and while participating in the activity, including preparation and travel time. The principal, along with the SBDM Council as required through consultation, shall assign coaches and sponsors for each extracurricular activity that are specific to MCMS and they shall complete all necessary training.

Civility

All extracurricular events are to be conducted in a civil manner. Concerns with a program or individual coaching concern are to first be addressed with the head coach or sponsor. If the outcome is not satisfactory then the concern is to be addressed with the principal. All discussions are to be civil, professional, and focused on the issue.
