SBDM Regular Meeting Minutes November 12, 2018 4:00 p.m. Conference Room

Members Present: Angie Akers-chairperson, Kellie Wise-teacher rep, Jessica Veatch-teacher rep, Sydney Cox-teacher rep, Patti Davis-teacher rep, Liz Morgeson-parent rep, Beverly Smalley-parent rep, Tiffany Brock-parent rep

Angie Akers called the meeting to order at 4:40 p.m.

1. Opening Business

a. Approval of the agenda—Angie Akers added purchase of headphones to the agenda. Kellie Wise added fundraiser approval to the agenda. Liz Morgeson made the motion to approve the agenda and Kellie Wise seconded. Council approved by consensus.

b. Approval of the minutes from the October 30, 2018 meeting—Kellie Wise made the motion to approve the minutes and Liz Morgeson seconded. Council approved by consensus.

c. Good News Report—Angie Akers reported that we have had a very busy time since our last meeting. Our girls placed 3rd in the district field day and our boys took 1st place. At the end of October, we held school-wide student-led conferences. Our Jr BETA participated in Reverse Trick or Treating with downtown businesses. Mrs. Akers also reported that Mrs. Lockard took a group of students to perform in the All District Chorus in Bardstown. Mrs. Akers also reported that our Fall Festival was a HUGE success, as well as our GES presentation at the recent board meeting. Mrs. Akers stated that Leadership Lebanon will attend our morning meeting on Friday, when we will celebrate Veteran's Day. Several classes have participated in field trips, including 1st grade to see our students perform in a local play, 5th grade participated in the Farm to Fork Day through the Marion County Extension Office and kindergarten visited a pumpkin patch. Ms. Wise reported that our certified and classified staff attended in a Google training on our November early release day. She also stated that Girls on the Run is hosting a clothes drive and BETA is hosting a food drive to benefit our GES FRC. Mrs. Davis reported that we are now one-to-one with Chromebooks in 1st-5th grade. Mrs. Veatch reported that our 4th grade will participate next Friday, November 16th, in a field trip to Lindsey Wilson to see a play.

5. Bylaw or Policy Review

a. Review/Approve Staff Time Assignment Policy (2nd reading)—Kellie Wise made the motion to approve the Staff Time Assignment Policy and Beverly Smalley seconded. Council approved by consensus.

b. Review/Approve Professional Development/Learning (PD/L) Policy (2nd reading)—Liz Morgeson made the motion to approve the Professional Development/Learning Policy and Tiffany Brock seconded. Council approved by consensus.

6. Headphones purchase—A teacher at Glasscock suggested purchasing headphones for our school. Council decided to order 10 headphones per class. Kellie Wise made the motion to order 10 headphones per class and Liz Morgeson seconded. Council approved by consensus.

7. Fundraiser Approval—BETA requested to hold a dance in December to raise funds for our BETA club annual trip to the BETA Convention. Beverly Smalley made the motion to approve the fundraiser and Liz Morgeson seconded. Council approved by consensus.

8. Closed Session: Reviewing of Applications KRS 61.810(1)(f) for certified and classified positions. –Jessica Veatch made the motion to go into closed session and Sydney Cox seconded. Council approved by consensus.

9.
