SBDM Regular Meeting Minutes May 14, 2018 5:00 p.m. Conference Room

1. Opening Business

a. Approval of the agenda—Kelly Rawlings made the motion to approve the agenda and Jamie Smothers seconded. Council approved by consensus.

b. Approval of the minutes of the April 9, 2018 meeting—Kellie Wise made the motion to approve the minutes and Liz Morgeson seconded. Council approved by consensus.

c. Good News Report—Mrs. Akers reported that last week was Teacher Appreciation Week. A HUGE thank you to our family volunteers and donations that made Teacher Appreciation Week so special. Mrs. Akers also discussed KPREP dress up days last week. Mrs. Akers reported that our 2nd grade went on a fun field trip to the zoo. Several other classes have field trips planned. Mrs. Green will be attending a Guided Math training in June. Ms. Wise reported that our Student Showcase was a huge success with a large number of families attending. Ms. Wise also reported that Ms. McCoy, the band teacher from Marion County Middle, played for 5th grade and shared information about middle school band. Mrs. Akers also reported that students who reached their MAP goal had the opportunity to dunk Mrs. Akers or Mr. Reed in the dunking booth.

d. Public Comment—Mrs. Daily Goatley addressed the council with concerns she has regarding the non-renewal process.

2. School Achievement

a. DRA assessment results—Mrs. Akers shared kindergarten, 1st and 2nd grade DRA reading assessment results for GES as well as the district average. Because Mrs. Smothers and Mrs. Rawlings have experience with administering the DRA assessment, they shared information about the DRA assessment as well.

3. Budget Report

a. Munis Report—(April) SBDM—7253.31, ESS--\$-232.85, Professional Development--\$410.62, District Activity Fund--\$16783.12, Transportation--\$2386.28 and Custodial--\$6650.42—Kelly Rawlings made the motion to approve the April Munis Report and Kellie Wise seconded. 4. SBDM Allocations

a. Approval of 2018-19 SBDM Allocations—Kellie Wise made the motion to approve the classroom and budget allocations. Liz Morgeson seconded. Council approved by consensus.

5. Update on Leader in Me—Mr. Reed gave an update on Leader in Me. He stated that we are still waiting on the 7 habits posters for our gym. They should be ready soon. He shared that there is a certified Leader in Me professional development on June 21st and that he will follow up with classified staff. He also stated that when students clip off their classroom behavior chart, he makes phone calls home to parents to inform families that their child is using the seven habits at school and being a positive role model for other students.

6. 2018-19 Master Schedule—Ms. Akers shared that the Master Schedule Committee is currently obtaining suggestions from staff and brainstorming ideas on how to ensure the 2018-19 master schedule will meet the needs of our students.

7. New Business

a. Council Elections—Mrs. Akers gave an update of current parent and teacher council elections. Parent members for the 2018-19 school year are: Liz Morgeson, Beverly Smalley and Tiffany Brock. Ms. Wise shared that teachers will vote for three teacher representatives on Tuesday, May 22, 2018.
