SBDM Special-Called Meeting Minutes July 10, 2018 5:00 p.m. Conference Room

Angie Akers called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

1. Opening Business

a. Approval of the Minutes of the June 14, 2018 meeting – Beverly Smalley made the motion to approve the minutes and Kellie Wise seconded. Council approved by consensus.

b. Good News Report – Angie Akers reported that we had a very motivating Leader in Me training for certified staff members on June 21, 2018. Liz Morgeson and Patti Davis stated that we had a nice turnout for our kindergarten and 1st grade JumpStart and that from a parent perspective the online registration was easy and convenient. Kellie Wise stated that it was apparent that we had a high number of GES students attending the Dream Bus sessions from the pictures posted on the MCPSD website.

2. Budget Report

a. Munis Report—SBDM-\$1763.02, ESS-\$0, Professional Development-\$132.62, District Activity Fund-\$19242.79, Transportation-\$1146.82 and Custodial-\$0. – Beverly Smalley made the motion to approve the Munis Report and Liz Morgeson seconded. Council approved by consensus.

b. School Activity Fund - \$20,217.66 Beverly Smalley made the motion to approve the School Activity Fund and Jessica Veatch seconded. Council approved by consensus.

3. Approve Classroom Configurations—Because of kindergarten enrollment, council approved classroom configurations as follows: 3-kindergarten classes, 1-kindergarten/1st grade class, 2-1st grade classes, 3-2nd grade classes, 3-3rd grade classes, 1-2nd/3rd grade class, 3-4th grade classes, and 3-5th grade classes. Council will continue to monitor enrollment throughout the summer and will adjust, if needed.

4. Approve 2018-19 Master Schedule – Council tabled until our next SBDM meeting.

5. Achieve 3000 and Smarty Ants instructional programs – Mrs. Akers reported that we will use funds to purchase these online instructional programs for the 2018-19 school year.
